

DCLG SET TO IMPROVE BOTH THE SPEED AND ACCURACY OF THE PROCUREMENT PROCESS THROUGH AUTOMATION

The Zanzibar solution (now the Basware Commerce Network), delivered by Procsolve (now a Basware company), was chosen by the Department for Communities and Local Government (Communities) to support their drive towards improving their procurement processes. Zanzibar has been successfully and seamlessly integrated into their existing SAP purchase-to-pay system.

It only took three months for Zanzibar solution to be implemented and for the Communities to start realising the benefits which they were aiming for, namely:

- Reducing paper from the procurement process
- Reducing manual errors
- Providing a technology platform for ensuring consistent pricing amongst suppliers and simplifying the process for adding new suppliers

Staff doing transactional procurement will now be able to focus on more value added activities rather than dealing with paperwork.

The Challenge

The existing SAP procurement system already included some electronic procurement functionality, but Communities wanted to reduce the operational overhead of maintaining the system. Adopting new suppliers onto their SAP platform was a time-consuming and resource intensive process.

Prior to the implementation of Zanzibar, only a few suppliers were integrated with Communities' SAP system, due to the complexity and expense of integration which also involved the use of a variety of file formats. The Department's procurement process involved the production of lots of paper which could go astray and cause delay. Manual intervention was often required to match the invoices to the original purchase order. Communities wanted to improve both the speed and accuracy of the procurement process through automation.

The Solution

Zanzibar was identified as a solution which could deliver these benefits as it uses a standard transaction format (cXML) for suppliers to trade electronically. Once implemented, they can trade with any other buying organisation that is subscribed to Zanzibar. Following the scope and readiness assessment, Procsolve (now a Basware company) supported the Communities with everything from the creation of the business case, to the integration of Zanzibar with the SAP infrastructure, to the first end-to-end transaction being processed. Procsolve delivered the implementation using the 'Delivering Change Effectively' methodology which concentrates on:

- Adopting users
- Adopting suppliers
- Managing communications and stakeholders
- Technical integration.


